Methodology

The majority of D & H's emissions arise from fuel consumption associated with the delivery, installation and maintenance of specialist medical lighting systems throughout the UK.

The Company occupies approximately 1,000 sq ft of office accommodation under a serviced lease arrangement where electricity and utilities are included within the rental charge. As direct electricity consumption data is not currently available, Scope 2 emissions have been estimated using standard UK commercial office energy consumption benchmarks.

The Company will seek to obtain actual consumption data in future reporting periods where available.

- Consider environmental credentials during supplier selection.
- Encourage sustainable procurement practices where commercially viable.

- Continue to encourage customers to switch to LED lighting to reduce reliance on halogen lights/bulbs
